Sano Souvenirs

Sano's specialty fresh ramen, imo fry (fried potato skewer), local udon and soba noodle products, Sano senbei (rice crackers), wagashi (Japanese sweets), manju (steamed sweet buns), local Sano sake, ceramic bells, local peaches, strawberries, pears, and other kinds of fruit, pickled vegetables, Tenmyō metal castings (a thousand years of tradition), Hina dolls, battledores, Mushi-e paintings, Kakejiku hanging scrolls

Sano Ramen

The ramen is characterized by the use of bamboo poles (Aodake 青竹) to pound the noodles flat. The noodles are made by hanging the chef's leg over bamboo pole, placing a lump of kneaded flour under the bamboo, and stretching it out by applying weight to it. The noodles have a firm texture and vary in thickness from medium-thick to thin or flat, depending on the restaurant. Although Sano ramen is characterized by 'Take-uchi' (using bamboo to make noodles) method, there are also noodle-making machines that can recreate this method of noodle-making, so not all Sano ramen shops are 'Take-uchi' just by hand. The soup of Sano ramen is a rich soy sauce taste, but it can be made from chicken bones, pork bones, seafood, or a combination, depending on the restaurant.

Tenmyō Metal Castings

Sano's Tenmyō metal castings have over a thousand years of history. There are various traditional handicrafts and products, such as tea kettles, boiler kettles, vases, and braziers.

Dolls

As Sano is also well-known as a town of dolls, its streets are dotted with many doll shops. Sano's majestic and delicate tradition of doll-making continues to live on even today.



SANO RAMEN MAP
















